# Ellsberg and the CIA Coverup

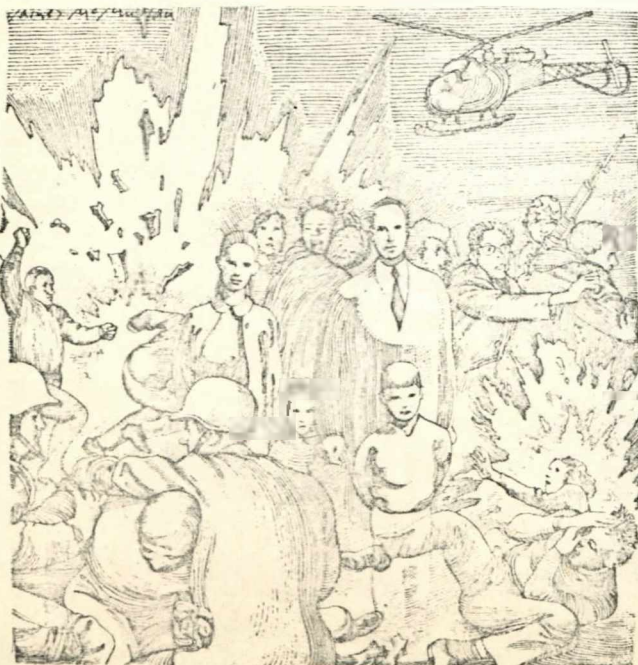
Too few of the Pentagon Papers were from the Pentagon, too many were written by the CIA. Many of the military figures, such as Edward Lansdale, Charles Bohannon, Lucien Conein, Bill Rossen, Arthur Arundel, Kyrus Phillips and others mentioned in the Pentagon Papers were really CIA. The purpose of this reconstruction of history was to whitewash the role of the CIA in the Vietnam war. These CIA papers put down the military and build up the CIA. Vietnam was a CIA operation to begin with. Covert forces and unmarked armies, cover stories and secret battles marked the start of the American involvement. Not until the Marines landed in 1964 in Vietnam did an element of American troops arrive in Vietnam that were not under the operational control of the CIA.

80% of the CIA effort is towards paramilitary operations and clandestine activities. Only a small part goes to intelligence work. With secret troops, the CIA could raise the level of fighting, detect it with its intelligence and recommend action in a closed loop cycle.

The Pentagon Papers only refer to the intelligence reports of the CIA, even though the clandestine activity could be doing the opposite. The impression the Pentagon Papers gives is "The CIA said that if the military did X, Y and Z activities, they would backfire. The military went ahead anyway, and it did backfire." That builds up the CIA as an expert intelligence operation, it ignores the covert organization that made the mess in the first place.

Ellsberg, with his experience with Edward Lansdale in Vietnam, was in a position to know the facts about the war and the papers he was helping to write. Why has no one made a distinction that most of the "Pentagon" Papers were not of military origin but came from the covert side of the CIA? Ellsberg was a CIA agent, an agency from which there are no unconditional resignations. Just because Nixon tried to screw him doesn't mean he is a saint. He is part of a slick coverup of the CIA's continuing role in Indochina. Someday the full truth of the Vietnam war will be told. So far, it hasn't come from Ellsberg.

# Counterfeit MONEY



Bank tellers usually tell counterfeits by the feel of the paper. US currency is expensive rag bond, 75% cotton, 25% linen with no wood pulp and no organic white dyes to make the paper look whiter. If a fake bill had 'optical brighteners' in it, it would make a white glow when viewed with ultraviolet light (3200-4000 Angstroms). However, did you know that it is illegal to make paper for Federal Reserve Notes? All the black ink in American money has small amounts of ferric oxide in it to give it magnetic properties. Bill changers made by National Registers, Inc. use a magnetic scanning head.

The treasury dept. uses an engraving process known as 'intaglio', lines etched deep for dark spots, shallow engraving for light spots. It gives a '3-D look' that is hard to duplicate with an offset press. There are many asymetries in bills, esp. the centering. Beware of any bill that is too perfect. The government makes a booklet 'Know Your Money' that explains which details give away fake money.

Did you know that Xerox makes a color copier that lets you use any paper you want?

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### Statement by David Holladay

I was born in Calaveras County, California in 1953. I have lived in California, Colorado, Illinois, Beirut Lebanon, and Massachusetts. My father is an old Testament scholar. He was a missionary for 7 years in Beirut, giving me a chance to travel extensively in Asia, Europe, and North Africa. I also gained an understanding of international intrigues and conflicts.

I was rejected by all my 'good' schools except MIT. I ended up in Bexley by accident. The story about telephone hacking in the Oct. 1971 Esquire was pointed out to me by my family. Though I was ignorant of it, I soon learned that all sorts of people around me knew about phone hacking. I was determined to equalize things and set about collecting everything I could get my hands on about telephones, especially hacking them. I soon learned that all sorts of sources were open and considered harmless. It was only when it was all put together that it became significant. What could be more boring than a list of international operators standard phrases. But if you are a phone phreak and don't know how to deal with overseas operators it could be very useful. I soon had a collection of printed material that surpassed anything else like it around MIT. I began writing phone companies around the world for information about accessing their system (only I would phrase it "how can your country be reached by the C.C.I.T.T. #5 switching system"). Israel even sent their manual they give to foreign operators. I punched up extracts of this information on IBM cards and gave out copies of the printouts. I got an intelligence report that Captain Crunch had a printout of mine, even though I only gave copies to friends at MIT. I have defrauded the Bell system out of only \$30 personally, though I must have spent at least twice that in information.

In my sophomore year I saw several news stories on the threat of "Backyard Atomic Bombs". I wrote up a poster signed by the "Backyard Bomb Coordinating Committee" and put up several hundred Xeroxs up around the campus. They all got ripped down to end up decorating MIT labs and dorms. But that was the point. Several friends of mine and I became the committee, and we printed up more posters, silkscreened ads and other paraphernalia. We sponsored an Atomic Bomb Design Contest. We got no entries, but that was OK, it gave us complete freedom to forge some winners. The BBCC has gotten into the MIT vocabulary as "a strange, unnamed source", used, for example to announce dope parties.

Around this time I developed an interest in the Kennedy assassination. I began Xeroxing articles, learning of some of the strange occurrences, and getting some of my friends interested in the subject.

I wrote up and printed the "Surviving a Nuclear War, a Guide for the MIT Student" in about a week. It gives a glimpse into the world of official emergency planning and is meant to be informative and to be a grossout. I sold about 40 copies at \$1 apiece.
